# 4. Steps were taken by the College to improve the quality of Education with regard to the following quality parameters of NAAC for the College: -

i. Curricular Aspects:

The college follows the curriculum prescribed by H.P. University. The college is following the CBCS curriculum with an annual system which has been started for UG classes from batch 2018-19 onwards as per guidelines from the H.P. University. The curriculum is being modified from time to time by the members of the Board of studies and the same is being followed in the college.

ii. Teaching - Learning & Evaluation:

Students are taught as per the courses provided by H.P. University. Regular classes are conducted and attendance records of the students are maintained. Blended teaching & flipped classroom teaching is also adopted. Different departments of the college organize students' seminars and Intra & Inter-Departmental quiz competitions, subject related workshops which involve the active participation of students. Field visits for practical work. The students are evaluated through their Mid Term Tests/House Examinations, Assignments, Presentations, Class Attendance, and Term-end/Annual Examinations.

iii. Research, Consultancy & Extension:

The faculty members are encouraged to participate in academic seminars, workshops, and training programs and to organize these in the college itself along with working on minor &major research projects. Our one faculty member is doing Ph.D. work in her subject and some are publishing papers in consultation with universities. The college actively remains involved in various extension activities and community services through the Red Ribbon Club, Road Safety Club, NSS, and Scouting.

iv. Infrastructure and Learning Resources:

The college is functioning in the new building acquired after the inauguration by CM in the month of September, 2021. It includes administrative and academic blocks. The administrative block consists of the principal office, Faculty conference room with digital teaching aids and internet connectivity, Library, Canteen, Girl's Common room, Staff room, Superintendent's office, Examination Hall, IT lab, Rooms for the music department, and separate washrooms for boys, girls, and for the people with disabilities. The library is furnished with special reading tables and chairs.

The academic block consists of six stepped floor well-lit and ventilated lecture theatres each with a sitting capacity of 100 students. Two big plane-floor classrooms, NCC, NSS, Scouting, and Watchman rooms, and separate washrooms for boys and girls are also available on the ground floor of this academic block. Freshly purified drinking water stalls are available in both blocks. A lecture theatre is equipped with a 62" LCD touch screen interactive panel with Wi-Fi and internet connectivity and a Hi-Fi camera for the career counseling and placement cell is available in the academic block. One more smart classroom with interactive panel, Wi-Fi and internet connectivity is

available for teaching the students. 2 projectors are also available which may be used as per the need in any classroom or hall for displaying the PPT etc. to the students. An IT Lab with 5 computers and internet Connection is also available. 5 Computers have also been installed in the college library. Separate computers with printers are available for the HPU examination cum RUSA cell and scholarship cell. The college website gcsarahan.edu.in is providing a facility for online admission, student account, faculty login accounts, and all vital information for visitors. BSNL Fiber internet connectivity is available in the college.

Student Support and Progression:

Students are motivated to contribute their creative ideas, thoughts, and innovations in the college magazine. Inter-college events are organized in college as per H.P. University sports / cultural calendar. There is a Career Counseling and Placement Cell in the college. The staff members also guide new entrants about CBCS, Anti-ragging, cleanliness and participation in various curricular and co-curricular activities for their overall development. The students excel in these activities and join in the field of their interest after completion of their graduation. Feedback from the alumni is collected through the feedback google forms and efforts for their incorporation are carried out for the betterment of the teaching learning process. College PTA also supports financially needy students if required. NSS, Scouting, Road Safety Club, Red-Ribbon Club, Eco-Club, Youth Red Cross, and Mentor-Mentee Groups are available for the student support system.

v. Governance and Leadership:

Various committees like Anti-Ragging, Discipline Committee, Grievances Redressal Committee, Women Grievances Redressal Committee, Building Committee, RUSA, IQAC, CSCA, UGC cell, scholarship cell, SC/ST cell, PTA, Alumni Association etc. The college regularly holds meetings with PTA and IQAC. The faculty is assigned the posts of Assistant Public Information Officer, Bursar, and Secretary of the Staff Council. The leadership by assigning various academic and administrative duties to faculty members by forming different committees for organizing functions and events. The committee members are allowed to function independently after due consultation with the Principal. Some of the committees also have student members.

vi. Innovative Practices:

The dynamic pursuit of the course curriculum, innovations in teaching methodologies, participative governance, and the promotion of inclusiveness in higher education and cultural activities are all continuous practices in the college. Being located in rural area the college is recognized for excellence in academics and cultural participation of students for their all-round development.
