## 5.1 Best Practices Description & Outcome of Best Practices (at least two)

### Best Practices (2024-25)

#### 1. *Igniting the Young Minds:*

Govt. Degree College Sarahan has introduced an innovative best practice titled *Igniting the Young Minds*, designed to broaden students' intellectual horizons and enhance their overall knowledge base. Through this initiative, students receive introductory lectures in subjects they have not formally opted for. For instance, those who do not study Geography or Music are taken to the Geography Lab and Music Room, where they are exposed to basic concepts, instruments, and their functioning.

Situated in a rural area with limited resources, the college recognizes the need to provide students with wider exposure and opportunities for personality development. As part of this program, every teacher delivers a lecture on a general yet enriching topic from their subject, the one that offers an overview while also holding practical relevance for students' lives. For example, students not enrolled in English Literature learned how literature can uplift the quality of their lives and elevate their worldview. The philosophy behind the initiative is simple yet powerful and in simple terms to teach students "*something of everything*."


#### **Outcome:**

The initiative successfully promoted an interdisciplinary outlook among students, enabling them to draw meaningful connections across subjects. Students also developed an appreciation for the unique value of each discipline. Notably, during quiz competitions, many were able to answer questions beyond their chosen fields (subjects), which simply reflected their expanded learning and curiosity to learn even about other subjects by pushing their boundaries.

#### 2. **The News Bulletin Initiative:**

The *News Bulletin Initiative* of Govt. Degree College Sarahan stands out as one of the institution's most impactful best practices, aimed at fostering awareness, communication skills, and confidence among students. Introduced to enrich the academic environment, this activity requires students to prepare and record a short, structured news bulletin (in audio format in their mobile phone) covering international, national, regional, and sports news. This audio recording was shared by the concerned teacher of their DSC and SEC subject in the college staff whatsapp group and then from there it is shared in the various students' groups on whatsapp. By continuing this practice in the academic year 2024-25, the college reaffirms its commitment to holistic development of students.

This initiative plays a crucial role in enhancing students' **current affairs awareness**, ensuring they stay informed about events beyond the classroom. In an age where information is vast and scattered, the News Bulletin serves as a guided and disciplined platform for students to regularly access and process news from reliable sources. ## REPORT

Inter-faculty and Inter-disciplinary lecture under the initiative 'Dated: 17/12/2024 Igniting the young minds' was organised by Jagmohan Thakur, Associate Professor, Department of Geography on the topic "**Basics of Globe and Map Reading**" at 11:00 AM in Geography lab. The purpose of the lecture was to make the students aware of the value and applicability of maps and globes in the study of geography as a subject. Using a globe as an example, the students were given a clear explanation of the earth's proportions & dimensions, the georeferencing system (Latitude and Longitude), the earth's rotation & revolution, and time zone concept to help them understand their daily lives. Further with the help of thematic maps, students were acquainted with the distribution of physical and cultural phenomenon on the earth and how we can interpret the thematic maps. At the end of the lecture, students were asked some questions regarding globe and map to check their understanding about the topic. In addition to this, the queries of students were also addressed and were asked to give their feedback on the lecture.



## **5. Special initiatives taken For:**

**5.2.1 Energy Conservation:** is one where sustainability, environmental responsibility, and cleanliness are prioritized to create a healthy, eco-friendly, and conducive learning environment. In the face of pressing global environmental challenges, educational institutions have an important role to play in leading the way toward sustainability and our college Govt. Degree College Sarahan has a clean green campus. This campus is single use plastic free, conservation of water takes place through rainwater harvesting. Campus is clean and green. Saplings are planted by Eco club and NSS volunteers every year in the rainy season. Students not only plant the saplings but ensure their protection and growth as well. There is a proper system of garbage disposal. Bio-degradable or organic waste and non-bio degradable waste are collected in green and blue dustbins respectively. LED bulbs are used in the campus to save the consumption of electricity. Most of the faculty members commute by pool in cars to save energy and to support the cause of environmental protection. Most of the students who come from nearby villages either reach the college on foot or in buses so this way they also support the cause of conservation of energy and protection of environment.

**5.2.2 Solid Waste Segregation/Management:** Cleanliness is next to Godliness so in order to keep the campus clean an employee has been engaged on hourly basis through PTA fund. It is ensured that dry waste and wet waste are dumped in separate dustbins by students and members of the staff. In every classroom we have kept dustbins made of cardboard/empty apple cartons for putting paper waste or other dry waste. It is also ensured by the college administration that washrooms are clean so that health and hygiene of all the stakeholders may be maintained. NSS volunteers also organize cleanliness drives from time to time to keep the college premises clean.

### 5.2.3

#### **1. Rain water harvesting and its use for gardening and cleanliness**

It is believed that India is going to face the vilest water crisis in the near future as many cities may run out of ground water. So efforts are being made from all sides to save water and conserve water. One of the most plausible solutions of this water crisis may be rain water harvesting. Keeping this vision of conserving and saving water, Govt. Degree College Sarahan follows the practice of the rainwater harvesting. Two underground tanks have been constructed (which were built during the construction of the college building as part of the original plan) in which the entire rainwater of the college building and campus gets stored. Then with the help of electric water pumps the water is supplied to the rooftop tanks from where it reaches to the cisterns of the toilets and is used for flushing in the washrooms. This water is also used for gardening as per the need. Rainwater harvesting is an important eco- friendly practice. It is a green practice which helps in keeping the groundwater level undisturbed and even charging the aquifers. It is quite useful in stopping soil erosion as well.

So rainwater harvesting is an effective and environmentally conscious practice that significantly benefits our college by reducing water consumption, cutting costs, and contributing to environmental conservation. In this way our college plays a crucial role in promoting sustainability. Moreover, integrating rainwater harvesting systems into the campus infrastructure provides an invaluable learning opportunity for students and fosters a culture of creating awareness about the sustainable environment through this green practice of water conservation.

### **5.2.4 Plastic Free Campus:**

#### **Polythene-Free Campus Initiative**

To promote sustainable development and eco-consciousness in our educational institution Government Degree College Sarahan, we have taken this initiative of making the campus Polythene free. The aim of this initiative is to eliminate the use of polythene (commonly referred to as plastic) in and around campus, thus reducing the environmental impact of plastic waste.

With an increasing global awareness of the harmful effects of plastic pollution, adopting a polythene-free policy can serve as an important strategy for promoting sustainability and environmental stewardship among students, staff, and faculty.

**There are some specific reasons why this initiative was taken:**

- **Non-Biodegradable:** Polythene takes hundreds of years to decompose, leading to long-term environmental pollution.
- **Wildlife Threats:** Polythene waste is harmful to wildlife, as animals can mistake plastic for food, leading to ingestion, entanglement, and often death.
- **Resource Consumption:** The production of polythene involves the consumption of fossil fuels, contributing to greenhouse gas emissions and climate change.
- **Waste Management Issues:** The enormous volume of plastic waste poses a formidable challenge for waste management systems, leading to choking of drains and unsightly litter in public spaces.

### **Steps to Achieve a Polythene-Free Campus:**

#### **1. Policy and Commitment:**

- The Principal, staff and the students are committed to eliminate polythene by following a clear policy of restricting the use SINGLE USE PLASTIC across campus.
- Engage NSS, CSCA, ROVERS AND RANGERS volunteers specifically along with the other students and faculty in discussions to ensure broad support for the initiative.

#### **2. Awareness Campaigns:**

- Volunteers of NSS organize various talks and drive to make the students aware about the hazards of the use of polythene and single use plastic.
- There are signboards painted in the campus clearly mentioning ONE USE PLASTIC FREE CAMPUS.

#### **3. Infrastructure Development:**

- We have installed a water dispenser connected with a water purifier to provide the safe drinking water to the students and to discourage the use of bottled water.

- We encourage the students and staff to use the reusable containers, bags, and utensils instead of Single use plastic items.

#### **4. Collaboration and Partnerships:**




### New Initiatives Started by Govt. College Sarahan (2024-25)
